



Candidate for Delegate Alicia Kallen Receives UMWA Endorsement

WISE COUNTY, Va.—The Virginia State Council of the United Mine Workers of America (UMWA) Coal Miners Political Action Committee (COMPAC) has officially endorsed Alicia Kallen, candidate for the office of delegate for District 1, the Commonwealth of Virginia House of Delegates.
